Commercial Applications:

Please Note that PG&E Gives a \$1.35 per sq.ft. back in a cash rebate for the installation of certain types of reflective and non-reflective films to help lower the air conditioning load.

Residential Applications:

The IRS now allows households to deduct a percent of the installation off their taxes. Certain window film products are being certified to be compliant with the internal Revenue Code, Section 25C for energy tax credit treatment.
